About The Venues

WelcomHotel (Inauguration Ceremony- 27 September)

Welcomhotel, Dwarka Sector-10 is well connected to various means of transportation, it's at a distance of 12km from Indira Gandhi International Airport and 24km from the New Delhi Railway Station, by road. The nearest metro station to the hotel is Dwarka Sector-10 which is a 1km walk away from the hotel, for convenience you can take a rickshaw from the metro station to the hotel which will cost in the range of ₹15-20.

How to reach WelcomHotel

To reach <u>Welcomhotel</u> by metro from the <u>Indira Gandhi International</u> <u>Airport</u>, you can take a 25 min metro ride to the <u>Dwarka Sector-10</u>, with an interchange at Dwarka Sector-21 metro station to the blue line towards Noida Electronic City or Vaishali.

From New Delhi Railway Station, to reach the hotel via metro you can take a 35 min ride to Dwarka Sector- 10 metro station through the orange line with an interchange at Dwarka Sector-21 metro station to the blue line towards Noida Electronic City or Vaishali

- The cab fare from <u>Indira Gandhi International Airport</u> to <u>Welcomhotel</u> ranges from ₹200 to ₹250
- The cab fare from <u>New Delhi Railway Station</u> to <u>Welcomhotel</u> ranges from ₹480 to ₹520
- The cab fare from Anand Vihar ISBT to Netaji Subhas University of Technology ranges from ₹800 to ₹1200.

About The Venues

Netaji Subhas University of Technology (NSUT) - 28, 29 September

<u>Netaji Subhas University of Technology</u> is well-connected to various modes of transportation due to its proximity to the airport, railway station, and other public transit systems, making it easily accessible from different parts of Delhi, neighbouring regions. Located in Dwarka, a planned city in the southwest of Delhi, roads and metro services conveniently link NSUT.

The nearest metro station, **<u>Dwarka Mor Metro Station</u>**, is **1.4 km** from the campus and can be reached by auto-rickshaw or a short walk.

- Nearest Railway Station: New Delhi (23 km)
- Nearest Airport: Indira Gandhi International Airport (16 km)
- Nearest Metro Station: Dwarka Mor (1.4 km)

How to reach NSUT

- The cab fare from New Delhi Railway Station to Netaji Subhas University of Technology ranges from ₹280 to ₹350
- The cab fare from <u>Indira Gandhi International Airport</u> to <u>Netaji Subhas University</u> of <u>Technology</u> ranges from ₹230 to ₹280.
- Rickshaw fare from <u>Dwarka Mor Metro Station</u> to <u>Netaji Subhas University of Technology</u> ranges from ₹15-20.
- The cab fare from Anand Vihar ISBT to Netaji Subhas University of Technology ranges from ₹800 to ₹1200.

<u>Indira Gandhi International Airport</u> is nearby, allowing easy access to the campus via cab, auto-rickshaw, or a 30-minute metro ride from Dwarka Mor metro station, with an interchange at Dwarka Sector 21 to the Airport Express Line (Orange Line).

New Delhi Railway Station is 23 km from the campus, which takes less than an hour to reach by any mode of transportation. For those preferring the metro, the Yellow Line of the Delhi metro can be taken, with an interchange at Rajiv Chowk to the Blue Line towards Dwarka Sector 21.

Transport From WelcomHotel To NSUT

The Campus Of Netaji Subhas University Of Technology Is Well Connected To Welcomhotel By Road And Metro, It's A Road Trip Of 12km Via Rickshaw With A Fare Of ₹120 To ₹140 Or A Cab With A Fare In The Range Of ₹160 To ₹200. Common Apps Whichyou Can Use Are Ola, Uber And Rapido.

You Can Take A 15-Minute Metro Ride **From Dwarka Sector 10** Metro Station Towards Noida Electronic City Or Vaishali, Travelling 5 Stations To **Dwarka Mor** Metro Station.

INDIRA GANDHI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO DWARKA SECTOR 10 (for WelcomHotel)

To travel from Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI Airport) to Dwarka Sector 10 using the Delhi Metro, follow these steps:

- 1. Start at IGI Airport Metro Station (Airport Express Line):
- From Terminal 3: IGI Airport Metro Station is directly accessible.
- From Terminal 1: Take the shuttle bus to Terminal 3.
 Board the Airport Express Line metro towards New Delhi. (Platform 2)
- 1. Get off at Dwarka Sector 21 Metro Station (after 2 stops). Follow the signs to switch to the Blue Line.
- 2. Board the Blue Line metro towards Noida Electronic City/Vaishali.(Platform 1)
- 3. Stay on the Blue Line until you reach Dwarka Sector 10 Metro Station (2 stops from Dwarka Sector 21).
- 4. Exit at Dwarka Sector 10 Metro Station Gate number 1.

Total Estimated Time: Around 25-30 minutes.

Note: The Airport Express Line fare is slightly higher than regular metro fares. The cab fare from Indira Gandhi International Airport to Netaji Subhas University of Technology ranges from ₹230 to ₹280.

NEW DELHI RAILWAY STATION TO DWARKA SECTOR 10 (for WelcomHotel)

To travel from New Delhi Metro Station to Dwarka Sector 10 using the Delhi Metro, follow these steps:

- 1. Board the Yellow Line at New Delhi Metro Station towards HUDA City Centre. (Platform 1)
- 2. Get off at Rajiv Chowk Metro Station (after 1 stop). Follow the signs to switch to the Blue Line.
- 3. Board the Blue Line metro towards Dwarka Sector 21.(Platform 4)
- 4. Stay on the Blue Line until you reach Dwarka Sector 10 Metro Station.
- 5. Exit at Dwarka Sector 10 Metro Station Gate number 1.

Total Estimated Time: Around 45-55 minutes, depending on train wait times. The cab fare from New Delhi Railway Station to Netaji Subhas University of Technology ranges from ₹280 to ₹350

INDIRA GANDHI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO DWARKA MOR (for NSUT)

To travel from Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGI Airport) to Dwarka Mor using the Delhi Metro, follow these steps:

- 1. Start at IGI Airport Metro Station (Airport Express Line):
 - Terminal 3: IGI Airport Metro station is directly accessible.
- Terminal 1: Take the shuttle bus to Terminal 3.
- 2. Board the Airport Express Line metro heading towards New Delhi. (Platform 2)
- 3. Get off at Dwarka Sector 21 Metro Station(after 2 stops). Follow the signs to switch to the Blue Line.
- 4. Board the Blue Line metro heading towards Noida Electronic City/Vaishali.(Platform 1)
- 5. Stay on the Blue Line until you reach Dwarka Mor Metro Station. (6 stops from Dwarka Sector 21)
- 6. Exit at Dwarka Mor Metro Station from Gate number 2.

Total Estimated Time: Around 30-40 minutes, depending on train wait times.

Note: The Airport Express Line fare is slightly higher than regular metro fares. The cab fare from Indira Gandhi International Airport to Netaji Subhas University of Technology ranges from ₹230 to ₹280.

NEW DELHI RAILWAY STATION TO DWARKA MOR (for NSUT)

- 1. Exit New Delhi Railway Station from the Ajmeri Gate side. The New Delhi Metro Station (Yellow Line) is right next to the railway station, just follow the signs to enter.
- 2. Board the Yellow Line metro towards HUDA City Centre(Platform1).
- 3. Get off at Rajiv Chowk Metro Station(After one stop). Follow the signs to switch to the Blue Line.
- 4. Board the Blue Line metro towards Dwarka Sector 21.(Platform 4)
- 5. Stay on the Blue Line until you reach Dwarka Mor Metro Station.
- 6. Exit at Dwarka Mor Metro Station from Gate number 2.

Total Estimated Time: Around 40-50 minutes, depending on train wait times. The cab fare from New Delhi Railway Station to Netaji Subhas University of Technology ranges from ₹280 to ₹350

OLD DELHI RAILWAY STATION TO DWARKA SECTOR 10 (for Welcome Hotel)

To travel from Old Delhi Railway Station to Dwarka Sector 10 using the Delhi Metro, follow these steps

- 1. Exit the Old Delhi Railway Station and head to Chandni Chowk Metro Station (Yellow Line). It's about a 5-10 minute walk.
- 2. Board the Yellow Line towards HUDA City Centre. (Platform 1)
- 3. Get off at Rajiv Chowk Metro Station (after 2 stops). Follow the signs to switch to the Blue Line.
- 4. Board the Blue Line train towards Dwarka Sector 21.(Platform 4)
- 5. Stay on the Blue Line until you reach Dwarka Sector 10 Metro Station.
- 6. Exit at Dwarka Sector 10 Metro Station Gate number

Total Estimated Time: Around 50-60 minutes, depending on train wait times.

OLD DELHI RAILWAY STATION TO DWARKA MOR (for NSUT)

To travel from Old Delhi Railway Station to Dwarka Mor using the Delhi Metro, follow these steps: 2. Board the Yellow Line towards HUDA City Centre(Platform 1)

- 1. Exit the Old Delhi Railway Station from Gate no. 3, pass by Court of Special Railway Magistrate and head to Chandni Chowk Metro Station Gate no. 3(Yellow Line). It's about a 5-10 minute walk.
- 2. Board the Yellow Line towards HUDA City Centre(Platform 1)
- 3. Get off at Rajiv Chowk Metro Station. Here, you need to switch to the Blue Line. Follow the signs to the Blue Line. Board the train heading towards Dwarka Sector 21.((Platform 4)
- 4. Stay on the Blue Line train until you reach Dwarka Mor.
- 5. Exit at Dwarka Mor from Gate number

Total Estimated Time: Around 50-55 minutes, depending on train wait times

ANAND VIHAR BUS STATION TO DWARKA MOR (for NSUT)

To travel from Anand Vihar Bus Station to Dwarka Mor via the Delhi Metro, follow these steps:

From Anand Vihar Bus Station, use the footover bridge and head to the Anand Vihar metro station

- 1. Start at Anand Vihar Metro Station (Blue Line):
 - Board the metro on the Blue Line (Line 3) towards Dwarka Sector 21.
- 2. Travel on the Blue Line:
- Stay on the Blue Line, passing through major stations such as Rajiv Chowk and Mandi House.
- 3. Reach Dwarka Mor:
 - Continue on the Blue Line until you reach Dwarka Mor station and exit from Gate 2.

Approximate Time: The journey should take around 55-65 minutes.

No Transfers Needed: It's a direct route, so you don't need to change lines.

ANAND VIHAR BUS STATION TO DWARKA SECTOR 10 (for WelcomHotel)

To travel from Anand Vihar Bus Station to Dwarka Sector 10 via the Delhi Metro, follow these steps:

From Anand Vihar Bus Station, use the footover bridge and head to the Anand Vihar metro

- 1. Start at Anand Vihar Metro Station (Blue Line):
 - Board the metro on the Blue Line (Line 3) towards Dwarka Sector 21.
- 2. Travel on the Blue Line:
- Stay on the Blue Line, passing through major stations such as Rajiv Chowk and Mandi House.
- 3. Reach Dwarka Sector 10:
 - Continue on the Blue Line until you reach Dwarka Sector 10 station and exit from Gate 1.

Approximate Time: The journey should take around 55-65 minutes.

No Transfers Needed: It's a direct route, so you don't need to change lines.
